

State Hospital Parking Regulations

- Parking is **not permitted** in any grass area on the west side of the roadway near the west field.
- Parking is **not permitted** along any roadway within the State Hospital grounds.
- Parked vehicles should have the engine turned off, keys removed from the vehicle, windows closed, and doors locked no matter where you are parked and how far away you are!
- Parallel parking is permitted on the east side of the roadway (by the west field) – cars must be completely off the road and within the white lines.
- Parking is permitted on the west side of the roadway (by the west field) in the gravel area only! White diagonal lines signify the end of the parking area.
- Parking is permitted in any of the parking lots near the main entrance to the hospital. **Do not** park in any reserved or handicap spots when parking near any hospital building.
- **Always pull into the parking spots. This includes the gravel parking area near the fields as well as parking lots near the hospital buildings. Violators will be ticketed and games could be suspended until the offending vehicle(s) are moved.**
- No parking is permitted in the Forensic Parking Lot. The parking lot should also not be used as a driveway when dropping off or picking up players at the U12 field.
- As long as cars do not cross the side walk parking is permitted along State Street.

Miscellaneous

- **All potentially dangerous items must be inaccessible and locked inside the vehicle**
- Vehicles must come to a complete stop at all posted STOP signs.
- Posted speed limit on Hospital property is 15 miles per hour.
- Alcohol and firearms are prohibited on State Hospital grounds.
- Do not leave children unattended at any time. This is especially true on the U10 and U12 fields!
